Any preparation undertaken prior to staring the project.

The impacts that have been made to patient care.

How your work or project has been evaluated.

Future plans for practice, next steps with your project.

The winner will receive a cheque for £500.00 and be expected to present their work at the 'Paediatric Continence Bladder and Bowel Education Meeting' in Manchester, which will be held on Tuesday 17th October 2019

Overnight accommodation and travel expenses will be provided if necessary.
