#### Who Can Enter?

The Bladder & Bowel UK Enuresis Award 2021, aims to recognise an individual or team, working within the NHS, or independent sector who is able to demonstrate that they have made a difference to the care of children or young people with bedwetting.

The award aims to highlight good practice and disseminate this to other health care professionals working with children and young people to enhance patient care.

The work needs to be focussed on the care of children and young people with bedwetting.

#### How to Apply

**Complete the application form and submit a 500-word summary, detailing the work you have undertaken. This should include:**

Project title and description.

What you have done and the motivations for the work.

Any preparation undertaken prior to starting the project.

The impacts on the care offered to children and young people and their families.

How your work or project has been evaluated.

Future plans for practice: the next steps with your project.

#### The Award

You, or one member of your team will be invited to present your work at the Bladder & Bowel UK symposium at Bolton Arena on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Travel expenses will be provided for the person presenting at the symposium and overnight accommodation if necessary.

**Closing date Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021**

Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.
